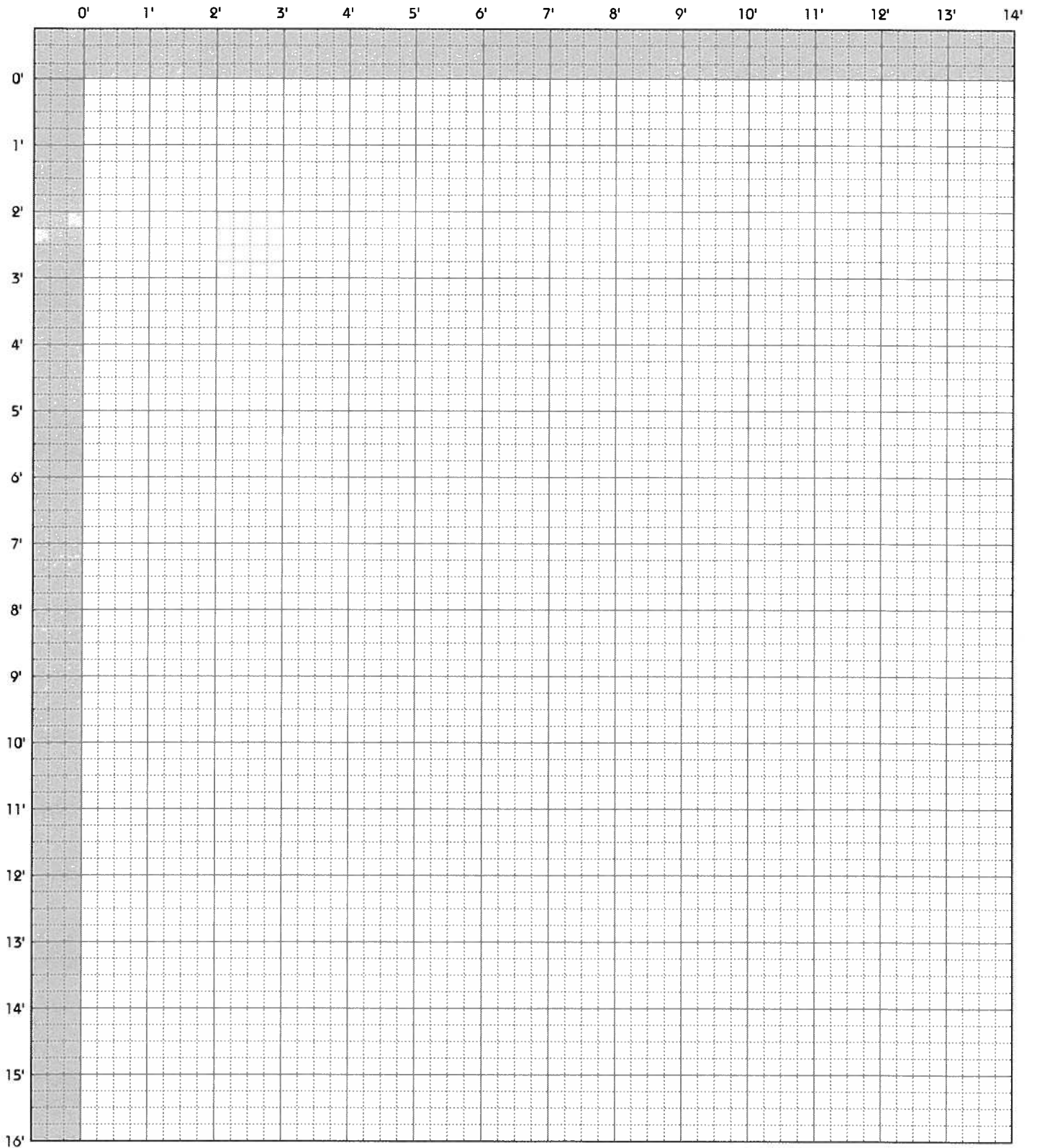




Scale: 1/2 inch equals 1 foot, each dotted line equals 3 inches. Measuring instructions on next page.





Step 1:

Start with left side of the wall that contains your sink. First measure the overall length of the wall. Record your measurements on the grid paper. Then measure to the first window, door, or wall. Continue clockwise around the room until each wall, window, and door has been measured and you have ended where you started.

Remember, when measuring doors and windows please include the trim as part of these objects.

Step 2:

Measure to the centerline of the sink from the nearest corner and record it. Measure and record the centerline of your range vent and any other permanent appliances.

Step 3:

If your kitchen has soffits, take measurements of the height, and width. In your kitchen has any base clearance issues, like low outlets or windows, record that as well.

Step 4:

Measure the ceiling height. The height may vary somewhat, so measure at more than one point.
